Guidance for members using the visitor pontoon.

York Motor Yacht Club welcomes visitors from other boat clubs. We have a few rules for clarity and harmony.

- Visitors are expected to moor at the downstream end of the visitor moorings and be prepared to double moor especially on the weekends of club events.
- Visitors should fly their club burgee and carry a members handbook to be able to prove club status if required.
- Visitors must never leave vessels unattended overnight without permission from the mooring committee.
- Visitors are reminded that York Motor Yacht Club is primarily a Friday to Sunday club and whilst efforts are made to provide electric and gate cards to visitors outside these days it cannot be guaranteed.
- Visitors must take direction from the mooring committee.
- Any deviation from these rules may cause a visitor to be asked to leave or incur a daily mooring charge.
